

PROBABLE CAUSE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL

CASE #: N-111-04-89

VIOLATION:

O.C.G.A. 35-8-7-.1 (A)(11)
Been suspended or discharged by the peace officer's
employing law enforcement unit for disciplinary
reasons.

MATTERS ASSERTED

It is hereby asserted that:

- 1.) Said officer is a certified peace officer.
- 2.) Said officer was employed by a law enforcement unit on 1-1-89.
- 3.) Said officer was suspended without pay from the law enforcement unit on 3-5-89 for disciplinary reasons to wit: violation of departmental policy and procedures.

CASE SUMMARY

Said officer was suspended and placed on probationary status for violation of departmental rules involving the use and carrying of an unauthorized firearm.

Specifically, on 3-2-89 the law enforcement unit received a complaint from an inmate that said officer had pointed a weapon at the inmate while inside the lock up area of the jail.

An internal investigation was ordered and conducted. The findings thereof are basically as follows:

On 3-1-89 said officer did carry a loaded weapon inside the lock up area of the jail. Said officer exhibited the firearm to the inmate in a threatening and/or intimidating manner. The weapon was an unauthorized weapon as dictated by departmental rules.

Said officer had worked as a detective for several years and only recently had been appointed as supervisor of the warrant division. During said officer's tenure as a detective, said officer and the inmate had become very closely associated. The inmate had provided information and assisted said officer on several occasions with the investigation of criminal cases. Said officer had provided legal assistance and favors to the inmate in return for the assistance rendered to the officer.

The relationship had become rather close and when the inmate and said officer would meet they would engage in mutual "horseplay" on a very friendly basis.

While in the jail on 3-1-89, said officer had in his possession a nickel-plated revolver. Said officer carried the weapon most of the time while on duty as an "extra" weapon.

Said officer inquired to a jail officer as to the location of the inmate. The inmate being in another room out of sight of said officer. Said officer came through a door and began "clowning around", "jiving" or engaging in "horseplay" with the inmate. When said officer removed the weapon from said officer's pocket and allegedly pointed it at the inmate. Said officer admitted exhibiting the weapon but denied pointing it at the inmate.

The investigation revealed that a similar incident possibly happened on two other occasions. One inside the jail and one outside while said officer was a detective.

No criminal charges were filed against said officer.

On 3-5-89, said officer was suspended without pay for 15 days and placed on probation for 6 months due to the undisputed fact that said officer did take a loaded weapon inside the jail. Said officer's carrying of the "extra" weapon without proper authorization and said officer's exhibition of the weapon was improper all of which are violations of departmental rules and procedures.
