

On Jan 11th 1999, Isaac Dankins was shot while driving his truck into Rume. A bullet fragment was recovered during the course of the autopsy, a frayed part of a bullet was recovered in the cab of a truck and a 9mm spent shell casing was recovered near the accident scene. It is this investigator's request that the evidence submitted be analyzed to determine if the evidence submitted can be associated with the bullet recovered from the person of Isaac Dankins. Isaac Dankins was shot from the rear as the bullet entered from outside the back/rear sliding glass window of the truck and then the bullet struck Isaac Dankins.

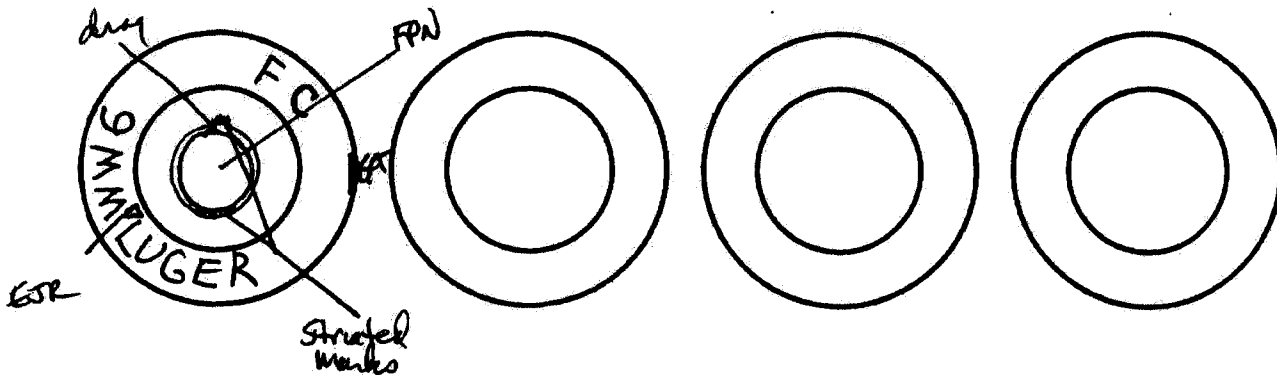

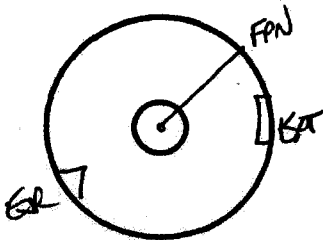
